Cavan County Museum will launch ‘Road to War – Path to Reflection’ Exhibition on **Friday 23rd March at 3 p.m.** *Road to War – Path to Reflection* tells the story of 15 people who died as a result of their part in the First World War. It details the lives of a number of Cavan men from different religious backgrounds who died on the same day, and often in the same battle. It also tells the story of a German prisoner of war who died in nearby Co Meath and a female nurse from County Roscommon. *Road to War – Path to Reflection*, serves as a means to reflect on the fact that the loss associated with conflict has no religious, community, or gender boundaries and reaches out to touch us all.
